VI. New Business a. Capital Expense Fund

Discussion around the capital expenses of Safe Home included first determining the expense for flooring replacement, then developing a capital improvement plan to highlight the upcoming major expenses. Finally, this plan will look at the potential for investment opportunities using the replacement reserve cash as a means to prepare for capital improvements. These investments may include Certificates of Deposit or money markets, with the goal of keeping a percentage liquid to be available for unanticipated expenses. The HRC agreed that this plan should be discussed with the County Commission before implementation.

b. Property Appraisal

A property appraisal of county facilities has been included in the FY24 County Commission Office budget. As part of this appraisal, Safe Home may be included for \$250. The HRC agreed that Safe Home should be made part of the appraisal.

Joy West updated the Commission on staffing, residents, and the work her and her staff are doing related to community outreach and staff development.
